Dear Parents

1. From time to time we require children to make short visits out of school, perhaps to the Museum in Hanley, or the local park. We are very strict about the ratio of adults to children which is never less than 8 children to 1 adult and very often is considerably better than this.
2. We also ask them to taste different foods (not meat) as part of their Science lessons and we need to know of any allergies, possibly to nuts or milk.
3. Sometimes children have toileting "accidents" and may need to be changed by a member of staff if a parent can't be contacted.

We need to know whether or not you consent to us washing your child if necessary, and changing him/her into clean clothes.

4. There are times when the local Press visits school to photograph or film important occasions. Some parents may not want their child included.
5. Year 3 – Year 6 children occasionally, throughout the year will be watching excerpts of/whole PG films in order to aid and enhance the reading of texts and discussion within a topic (you will be able to see what and when your child will be watching through your child's half termly overview).
