Dear Mums, Dads and Carers

I write regarding demolition work along **Ludlow Street** and **Balfour Street**.

You will have already seen areas fenced off. Contractors have now informed me that demolition works will commence in this area on 12<sup>th</sup> December for approximately 9 weeks. This is likely to cause disruption to parents at drop off and pick up times.

In the new year there are plans to completely close off Ludlow Street and Balfour Street so this will add further congestion to the area.

The staff car park is not available to be used by parents and I urge you to make sure that you use St. Ann Street car park during drop off and pick up times. Parents must not park on corners, double yellow lines or on the zig-zag lines outside school. The camera car will be in the area regularly to enforce parking regulations.

St. Ann Street is just 2 minutes walk away from school. It will help to keep children safe as our immediate area will be less congested.

We write to inform you that CMEC Demolition Ltd have been awarded the demolition contract of Hanley Phase 4 and will be carrying out the works on behalf of City of Stoke-on-Trent Council which includes:

- Ludlow Street 19-41 (odds only) – 12 properties
- Ludlow Street 18-22 (evens only) – 3 properties
- Balfour Street 2-4 (evens only) – 2 properties

Works are due to start week commencing 5<sup>th</sup> December 2016 for 10 weeks, with working hours 7:30am – 4:30pm Monday to Friday.

We ask you to be aware of a slight increase of traffic to and from the project and would like you to inform any visitors or children that might be visiting your property.
