Early Years Pupil Premium – Eligibility Check

Dear Parent/Carer

Some children aged three or four may be eligible to benefit from the Early Years Pupil Premium. The premium, worth up to £300 per child per year, is paid directly to your child's school for the purpose of improving the quality of early education for your child and ensuring that they are given the best start towards educational achievement.

In order to identify those children who may benefit, the local authority will need to confirm eligibility by carrying out a simple check. Families who receive one or more of the benefits listed below (within the declaration), are likely to be eligible to the early years pupil premium, which the school will receive to enhance your child's early education experience.
