After another most successful Year 5 ICT Action Adventure weekend to the Kingswood Educational Activity Centre in Penistone, Yorkshire last year, we are proposing to take our present Year 5 children for a similar experience from Wednesday 27th until Friday 29th April 2016. The children will leave school on the Wednesday morning and return to school at approx. 3.00 pm on the Friday.

The children will have the opportunity to experience ICT in a practical, fascinating way, while also testing their mettle with a series of challenging outdoor activities, such as Zip Wire, climbing, archery and raft building. This will be a similar experience to the one the children will have in Year 6 when they visit Stanley Head for the week but with more of an emphasis on computing.
