I write to remind you of the disruption we face over the coming weeks with the road calming measures taking place outside school on Wellington Road.

You will already be aware from earlier letters that we will be affected by road closures during half term and by traffic controls in the future. I would like to inform you that access to school will not be affected during the school day as contractors will ensure that the gate to the office/reception can be accessed at all times. Works will begin at 9.30 a.m. and cease at 3.00 p.m. to allow for access.

Parents will need to be aware that any parking on the upper section of Wellington Road will be unavailable. I would like to remind you of free parking on St. Anne Street and lower down Wellington Road, just past the shop. It is likely that there will be increased parking patrols during this period so please ensure you park safely and legally so that you don't get a ticket! We will work closely with the contractor to ensure the works run as smoothly as possible and keep you informed about any developments.

Our first Monday back after half term is likely to be very challenging. Please be aware.
