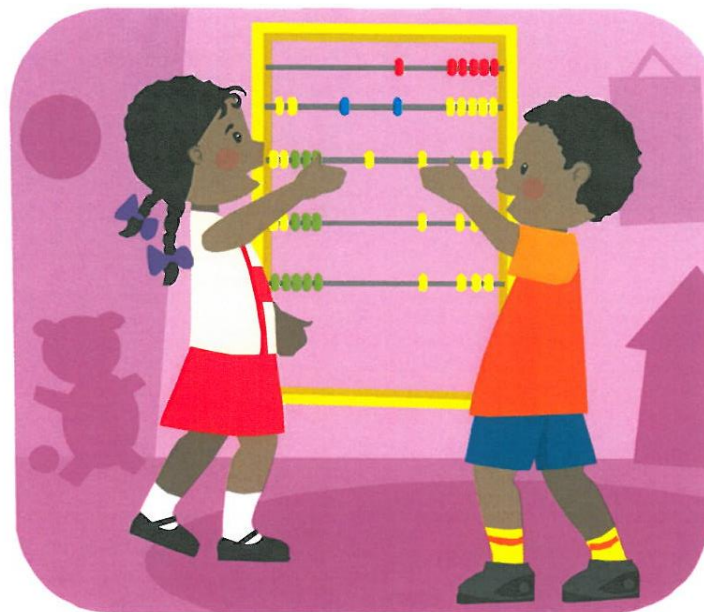

Autumn Term 2 - Winter Uniform. Shirt (Pale Blue), School Tie, Skirt/Dress (mid-grey), Shoes (Black), Socks (Grey). Sweatshirt (Royal Blue).

**Building Works** – As you can see our building works are now in full swing. Once completed we will have 4 new teaching areas.
