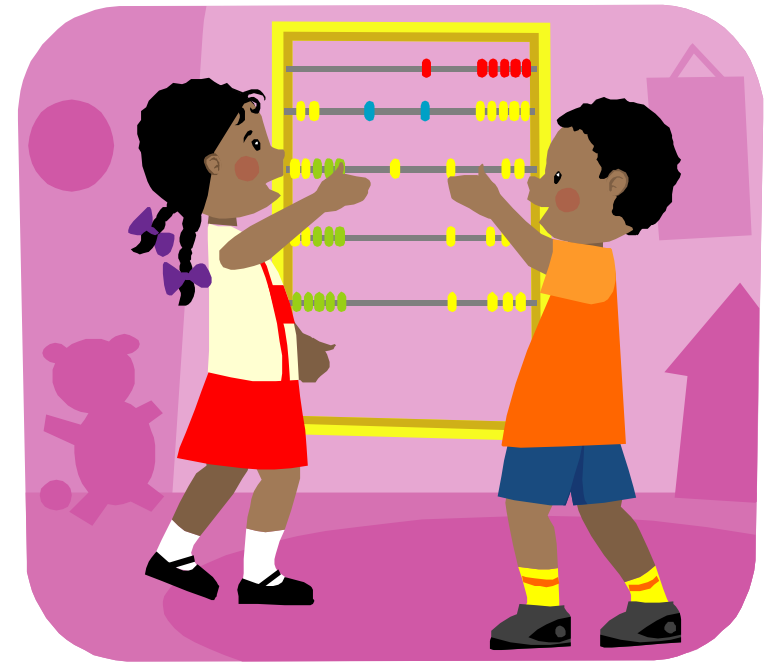

**Uniform** – Please ensure that your child wears the correct uniform for school. #### Boys

#### Girls

Autumn Term 1 – Summer Uniform. Polo shirt (pale blue), Skirt/Dress (Mid Grey), Gingham Dress (pale blue & white), Shoes (Black), Socks (Grey/White), Cardigan/ Sweatshirt (Royal Blue).

Autumn Term 2 (from October half term) - Winter Uniform. Shirt (Pale Blue), School Tie, Skirt/Dress (mid-grey), Shoes (Black), Socks (Grey). Sweatshirt (Royal Blue).

**Curriculum** – We will be sharing information for parents on our curriculum and how we assess it during the autumn term. Lots of information will be posted online and we will let you know when it is available.
