Dear Mums, Dads and Carers,

I write to provide further information for our fast approaching Battlefields trip.

After visiting RE Farm in October 2014 it will be necessary to ensure that the children have warm clothing as the area is quite bleak and has cold winds. We have decided that uniform will not be necessary at any point during the visit. The important thing is to pack warm clothes and comfortable shoes. The coach company have asked me to point out that there is limited space for luggage so have asked that children are careful of how much they bring. We must also remember that we are only away for 3 days!

Suggested list:-

- Items that the children are wearing to travel in plus:
- T-shirts
- Sweatshirts
- Change of trousers
- Spare pair of shoes/trainers
- Waterproof coat, scarf, gloves, hat
- Underwear
- Toiletries (Towels are provided by the hotel)

Please aim to pack this into the smallest case you can. Children may take a small piece of hand luggage that may contain items to keep them amused during our travel. Electronic items such as PSP's and DS's are fine but remain your child's responsibility for safe keeping.

During our meeting on 20th January 2015 you will receive a medical form to complete and return.

Mobile phones will not be allowed on the visit. We will keep you fully informed of our progress via text messages and supply you with an emergency contact number.

Inhalers will need to be carried with the children at all times. Any sickness bugs within 48 hours of travel will prevent your child from attending the visit. Please inform us at the earliest opportunity should this be the case.
