Dear Parents/Carers

The end of term is fast approaching and the Y1 teachers are already thinking about September and the activities that they are going to be planning for your children.

We have already begun to change the layout of the classrooms in preparation for the autumn term and I am confident that the children are going to like the plans the staff have for their new rooms.
