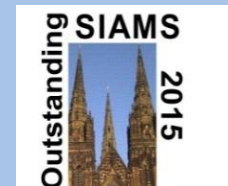
## Key Stage 2 Transition

Your child will be moving from Year 2 (the final year of Key Stage 1), to **Year 3 (The first Year of Lower Key Stage 2).**

## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

- Year 3 is an important year to encourage the children to be more independent.

- Need to take responsibility for their own learning and resources, e.g.

- Remembering P.E. kit, bringing in homework on time, returning letters, changing reading books.

- Many of the routines and learning experiences are similar to those experienced in K.S. 1. Behaviour system is the same.



# Class Dojo-Behaviour System

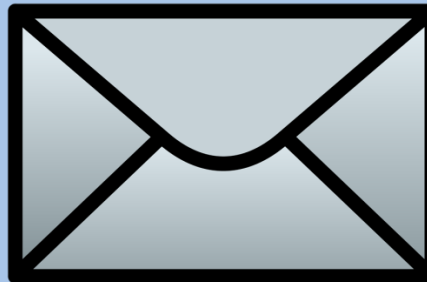
- Please check Class Dojo regularly for important updates, to track your child's behaviour and to keep in touch with the class teachers.





## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

- Enter school as before in the morning between 8:45am and 8:55am through the **top doors** opposite the playgrounds.
- As they come into school they put their sandwich boxes on the **trolley** outside the staff room
- They hang their coats up at the **back of the stage** and put their bags into the **pigeon holes**
- They take their reading books and pencil cases, letters and money (when needed) into the classroom.





## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

- **Playtime** is at 11:00am every day. We stagger our playtimes now, so that Y3 and Y4 go out together at 11.00 and Y5 and Y6 go out together at 10.45.
- This means that each year group has a yard to themselves, alternating with the activity yard, there are books, maths and science activities to use at these times, in addition to PE equipment.
- The arrangements for milk and juice are the same as in K.S. 1 but unfortunately the children don't get free fruit each day.
- However, we do encourage them to bring their own piece of fruit in from home to eat at playtime.



# Lunch Times

- Dinnertime is 12:30 p.m. Until 1.25 p.m.

Each year group goes down to the dining hall on a rota basis, supervised by lunchtime supervisors.

- If a child receives a red card, then detention will be during dinner time, and the children will complete a reflection sheet to help them improve their behaviour.





# Lunch Times

School meals cost £12 each week.



Please pay each week on a Monday, via school money.

**If think that you may be eligible for free school meals pop to the office at any time.**

- All children in KS1 were entitled to free meals, this is not the case in KS2. **Meals are no longer free for all children!**



## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

•At the end of the day, parents meet their children down at the **slope near to the habitat garden**. The teacher will accompany the children down the slope to the point where the children can see their parents

•The rules are the same as in K.S. 1, whereby if a child can't see you they must wait with their teacher sensibly.



•At approximately 3.25 when all the other children have been collected the children will be taken to the Reception area to wait for you.



## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

- Ties must always be worn with shirts and black shoes, not trainers, must be worn.
- Shirts (including polo shirts) must be tucked in at all times.
- If for any reason they can't wear the correct shoes could you send in a note explaining the reason
- Long hair should be tied up, and hairstyles must be in line with school policy i.e. No patterns shaved in.
- No nail varnish.

### P.E. Kit



- It is also important that the children wear the correct P.E. Clothes
- Royal Blue shorts/skirts/leotards
- Royal Blue T-shirts
- Dark coloured tracksuit for outdoor.
  
- Indoor P.E. for Y3 is to be decided, staff will let you know.
  
- Outdoor- Dark coloured Tracksuit



## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

### Outdoor P.E.

- Outdoor P.E. is on Wednesdays
- The children need to wear their indoor kit with a dark coloured track suit on top and trainers
- We also ask that in their P.E. bag they have a towel and a change of underwear in case during the lesson the weather unexpectedly changes for the worse. The children can then dry off and dress comfortably for the remainder of the day.

### Swimming

•The children will go swimming in the Autumn Term- new approach, whole school.

-All children will need a swimming cap!

-No long shorts- trunks only for boys.

-Children can still swim with verrucas.





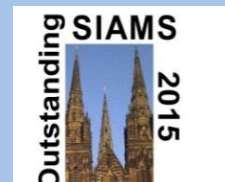


## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

### Jewellery

- If they have pierced ears and they wear earrings for school they should be small studs only.
- The children have to remove their own earrings for P.E. and swimming, the staff are not allowed to do it and the children are not allowed to put plasters on them
- This is the LEA ruling not the school decision





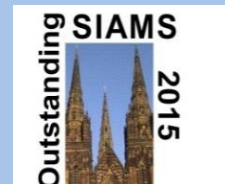
## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

### Pencil Cases

- The children are allowed to bring pencil cases into school
- They do not need a fountain pen, felt pens or gel pens
- They do not need compasses or calculators
- They don't need to be too big or they won't fit in the trays under their desks





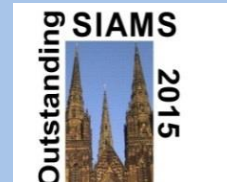

# Reading



- Reading remains of high importance as the children move into K.S.2
- There will be **lots of opportunities for your child to read to the teachers during weekly reading sessions and as part of the daily curriculum activities.**
- We therefore ask that the responsibility of hearing the children read their book moves to the parents at home, **a little as often as possible.**
- The children will have a reading log which we ask you to keep up to date and return to school daily with reading books.



## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

### Homework



- Reading and Key Maths skills practise are required on an ongoing weekly basis, as often as possible.
- New times tables booklets/ Times Table Rockstars
- Children who read the required 4 times per week will receive extra playtime.



## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

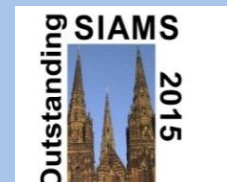
- Reading with understanding:

After the children have read to you can you **ask them questions to check their understanding**, e.g. Setting of story, characters, plot etc.

- Changing reading books:

- Child's responsibility
- Choose their own books from the library to maximise reading for enjoyment
- Recorded in Reading Log
- Reading tree or ladder in class





## Hanley St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School.

### Curriculum

- **New Curriculum** from Sept 2014 throughout the school whereby English, Science, RE, History, Geography, Art/D&T and IT will all be linked to the particular topic e.g.

- **Autumn** : Fantastic Mr Fox/ The Stone Age/ Iron Age/Bronze Age

- **Spring**: The Romans

- **Summer**: Charlie and the Chocolate Factory/ Where Food Comes From

- **Termly** overviews will be sent home.

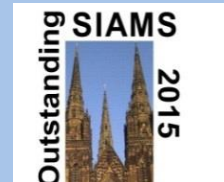
