## Re Corona Virus

You will no doubt be aware that the current advice for schools is to carry on as normal with increased precautions such as repeated handwashing and identification of anyone who may have returned from an affected country. School is rigorously following this guidance.

Of course, we are aware from recent government announcements that there is an increasing possibility that at some point schools may be forced to close. If this happens, we want you to be as prepared as possible so that your child can continue to access quality learning materials from home. So this week can I ask you to check a number of things so that in the event we have to operate remote learning, that you will not encounter any difficulties:

- Is your Dojo account active as this will be the main communication tool between teacher and parent/ child?
- Does your child know their Times Table Rock Star (TTRS) Log in details?
- Does your child know their Bug Club Log in details (usually the same as TTRS)?
- Does the school have your correct mobile phone number so text messages can be readily received?
- Does the school have an up to date email address?

Of course, if your child will not have access to a computer/mobile device/tablet then it would be helpful if you let your child's class teacher know so that we can consider sending paper based activities home, if the need arises.

At the moment, I have no more information than you and I am acting on the existing Public Health England advice to schools. When this changes, I will notify you at the earliest possible opportunity.

In the meantime please ensure your child washes their hands before arriving in school and ensure that you are aware if any friends or family have recently returned from countries identified as being a higher risk.
