	ACTION REQUIRED
1. Getting to the Premises Maintain adequate access to the premises and parking provision and routes around school	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure markings visible and maintained to disability space.• Ensure maintenance of steps visibility markings• Tactile paving to top and bottom of steps• Consider remote operated front door to main reception when funds allow• Ongoing maintenance of signage• Ongoing maintenance of lifts
2. Improve Access to the Curriculum	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Dailey checks for children wearing hearing aids and ensure that seated in most appropriate position in classroom or learning spaces to maximise understanding• Ensure HI support services train staff as necessary in use of aids and teaching strategies• Ensure pupils with difficulties regulating emotions have access to calming sensory space to support access learning• Ensure access to technology to support learning to meet individual needs
3. Improvements in the provision of information for pupils	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure availability of written school documentation in alternative formats when requested or employment of signer or interpreter formats when requested or employment of signer or interpreter to aid understanding• Embrace technology to support translation on information given to parents and use of simplified text and supporting icons where appropriate to aid understanding
